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## PHILIP FREY Fresh Ways

Painter Philip Frey has found a new freedom. In the past year he has transitioned from acrylic to oil while exploring an approach to the landscape that leans into the abstract.

Frey has always welcomed abstraction, but the oil medium has allowed him to bring a new dynamic to his brushwork and palette. Working wet into wet, he relishes the flow of paint and being able to blend hues and produce effects not possible in acrylic.<sup>1</sup>

At the same time, Frey has loosened his ties with the motif. He is less beholden to on-site sketches and photographs as he develops the larger pieces, on canvas and panel, and takes greater license with the world around him.<sup>2</sup>

The stand-outs of the show are several paintings based on memories of islands off Hancock and Schoodic Points and Grindstone Neck, a stretch of coast to which Frey continues to lay painterly claim. These iconic shapes set against the sea and sky have a modernist edge, bold yet dream-like.

The exhibition features a number of fine small sketches, among them, a study of docked dinghies at the Winter Harbor Yacht Club and a view of Little Long Pond on Mount Desert Island. Frey also returned to Monhegan, to paint its companion island Manana, and has taken another turn at rendering a favorite fishermen's co-op.

This new work will broaden the Philip Frey fan base, which has grown in recent years in response to radiant downeast landscapes and a notable series of portraits of Ellsworth. Like the painter, we welcome a fresh way of viewing our part of Maine.

#### Notes

The text is based on a visit to Frey's Sullivan studio on May 23, 2011.

- 1. Frey has not abandoned acrylic. In some of the smaller pieces, the medium serves as the base for oil.
- 2. A conversation with Alex Katz at the Farnsworth Art Museum last year helped Frey refine this process. Katz described the steps he takes working from small to large, and how he tries to complete the final painting in one go, a notion Frey found liberating.


